

Senior College Planning

- Check your credits for graduation and your schedule of classes.
- Senior Parent/ Student night in September.
- Register to take the SAT or ACT test if you have not done so or if you want to retake the test to raise your score.
- Please make sure to register for the SAT Subject Test if required or recommended by a university or college. Subject tests are taken on a different day.
- Finalize your list of colleges you want to submit applications to.
- Be aware of admission and scholarship deadlines for your colleges.
- Submit College Applications online.
- Apply for Scholarships throughout the year. (Refer to Scholarship Link)
- Attend College Fair in October. (Refer to Calendar of Events)
- Counselors visit senior advisory's in the fall and spring semesters.
- Late August or Early September: Students begin meeting with their counselors individually.
- Submit housing reservations as required by your colleges.
- Aim for completion of all college applications by December 1, 2011.
- Submit Financial Aid Application. (Deadlines are important)
- In late January or early February Mid-year Reports are sent out. (This is required for colleges on the common application.
- Register for AP Exams through the counseling office. (Mr. Marcelo Eureste)
- Complete all AP Exams in May.
- In the Spring Mrs. Ramirez finalizes the Graduation list of colleges with each student for graduation.
- Student's transcripts are sent out automatically in June.
